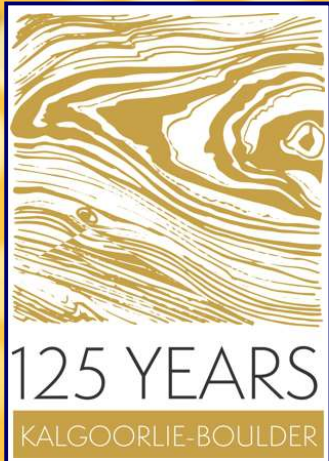

2018 WA OPEN



The Women's Open (PSA CS) was a 16 player draw, with a combination of local, national and international talent.

Challen Stowell (Gold Coast), Trace Johnson (NSW) and Ananata Prasertalanakul (Thailand's #1 player) were competing against our local players.

There were several upsets in the main draw with the top three PSA seeds defeated by local players.

Everyone was expecting a great show down in the final with the top two players from WA playing off - Sue Hillier and Amanda Hopps.

Hillier and Hopps had played each other many times over the years and both were looking forward to the final. Unfortunately, Amanda injured herself in the second game and was unable to continue.

Sue Hillier reflected on the match "I was looking forward to a great match. I have the utmost respect for Amanda, she plays a great game, is so competitive and we know each other's game so well.

I was surprised how nervous I was, which was evident with my first serve of the match. I settled down towards the end of the first game which was close as expected. I started the second well, but unfortunately Amanda hurt her calf. Not the way I wanted to win. However, winning my 8th title at age 55 is an achievement I'm proud of ... considering my first title was age 25!"

Post match Amanda Hopps said "Sue played well to take the first game. It was disappointing to injure my calf muscle and pull out of the match but all accolades to Sue for winning her 8th title."

The Men's WA Open saw #2 seed David Illich bundled out early by Scotsman Graham

Melvin. All other seeds won through to the quarter finals.

Local players Mike Corren and Tim Cowell were in the semi-finals. Corren had a tough 5 setter to make it through to the final, while Cowell lost his semi 10-12 in the fourth denying an all WA final like in the women's event.

The men's final saw some fantastic rallies with Corren winning the first game 19-17 and taking the second 11-9. Man Chin worked hard to win the third game only for Corren to step up a gear to take the fourth game and close out the match 11-3.

Past champion Dean Williams provided his analysis of the match "the final was played between a very experienced Mike Corren and a young Singaporean who fetched everything thrown at him but Mike's use of his body at crucial times was the telling factor in the first 2 games which could have gone either way with both players having game balls.

The first game was a must win for the 43yo Corren as it went on and on to finally reach 19-17. The second was similar with Corren once again just edging out his younger opponent. Corren was feeling some calf tightness and eased off a fraction and that was all his opponent needed to take the 3rd.

With a handy rest and some much needed massage, Corren came back and dominated the 4th to win his 7th WA Open to be only 2 behind myself. A great effort at 43 to hold at bay the young overseas players".

At the presentation Mike Corren said "it was good to have the Singapore players here to add an international element to the tournament and good to play some hard competitive squash against them. Was great to get good match practice for upcoming events."

The players now prepare for the Golden Open in Kalgoorlie from the 1st to 4th June.

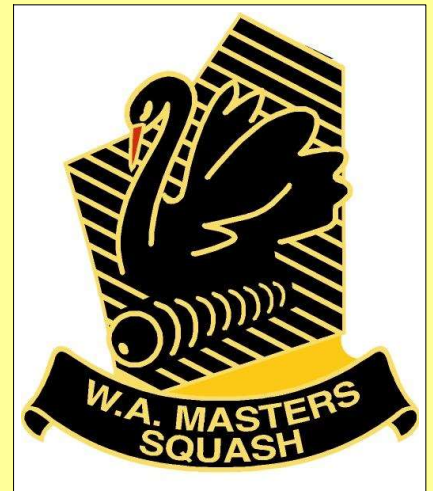


WA MASTERS MAY UPDATE

We are nearing the middle of the year for Masters Squash. We have had a number of events so far with a few to go. I would like to review where we have been and where we are going for the rest of the year.

The year began with the **Tussle on the Terrace** event, where approximately 50 players competed in teams to kick off the season. As always, the competition was well enjoyed by all, and plenty of supper and camaraderie finished the evening.



On to the **South West Teams** event organized by the Busselton Squash Club but held in Bunbury because of court uncertainty. A full schedule of matches across the three days of the long weekend went off smoothly.

Bunbury were the major winners over the long weekend winning three of the divisions including Divisions one and two. Some of the players I worked with as juniors a couple of years ago, or so it seemed, are now eligible and playing masters. Perhaps I have been doing these things for too long.

The next event was the **Hilton Individuals Masters** tournament with seven divisions and approximately 45 players. Division 1 was extremely strong with a number of State grade players showing the rest of us how the game can be played. Great sponsors with Jetts Fitness and squash.com.au providing a number of prizes, once again supporting Masters Squash.

Friday Night Masters continues with a core group of players turning up each week. We are trying to achieve six teams of six each week. And, with pull-outs, managing to get around thirty. Replacements and reserves are constantly required so if you are interested in playing please contact Kane.

Last week on Friday we celebrated three upcoming 70th birthdays of regular players that will be reaching that milestone over the next few weeks. Congratulations to Rhonda Thomas, Alison Williams and Shirley Dug. We also have another couple of very significant birthdays coming up over the next couple of months.

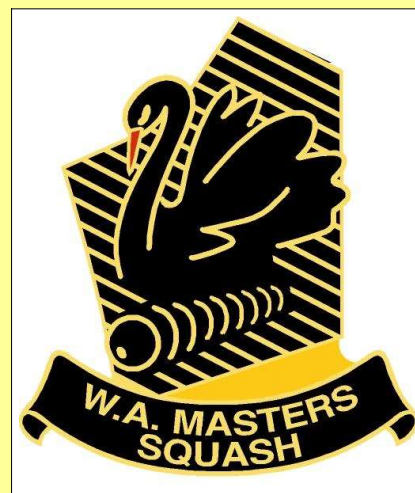

Coming up we have the **State Masters Championships** to be played at Squashworld Mirrabooka over the weekend of 20-22 July. We normally get around 100 players participating and we hope this year will be no different.

WA MASTERS MAY UPDATE

It is a chance for you to find out where you stand amongst players of your own age. There will be age groups in five year brackets from 35-40 for both men and women. We expect to have players from 35 to 90 playing, so plenty of room for everyone.

We have a few players in WA who have performed spectacularly over the last few years winning World and Australian titles. You very seldom get the chance to compete against players of that level but this is your chance. You may not win but the chance to say you played a world champion is rare and to be treasured.



We understand players may have other commitments over that weekend, but we will always do our best to accommodate players requests.

The committee are looking at a venue and date for a **winter get-together**. This is likely to be early in August and we are trying to find a central venue. It is likely to be either a Saturday night or Sunday lunch along similar lines to the Christmas function held at the Royal in East Perth at the end of last year.

We are also providing the **Entertainment Books** for sale again this year. It is a good money maker for Masters and provides a great return for the users. 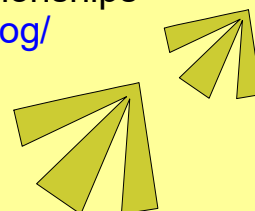
The Australian Masters Championships will be held during the first two weeks of September in Hobart. If you are interested in going you should contact a committee member to let them know.

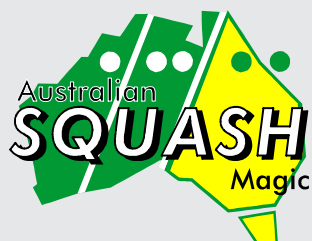
The first event on the **Southern Grand Prix Squash Circuit** was conducted on 19th May at Katanning.

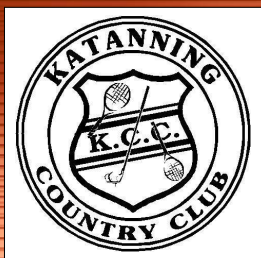

Whilst numbers were slightly down the event was still enjoyed by 27 youngsters keen to strut their stuff! 12 juniors from Katanning participated with Dean Pinney winning Division 4 in an all Katanning event. Noah Daprille finished 2nd whilst Harry Forman finished 3rd.

Locals Toby Quartermaine finished runner up in Division 2 whilst Jackson Barberien finished runner up in Division 3. Rounding out the placings for the Katanning juniors saw Elijah Quartermaine finish 3rd in Division 3. That gave the hosts a win, three seconds and two thirds.

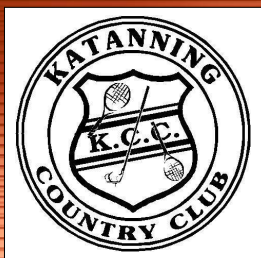
They had some great rallies, but Max was in a hurry to go on his honeymoon. His greater speed down the aisle gave him a strong victory in three.

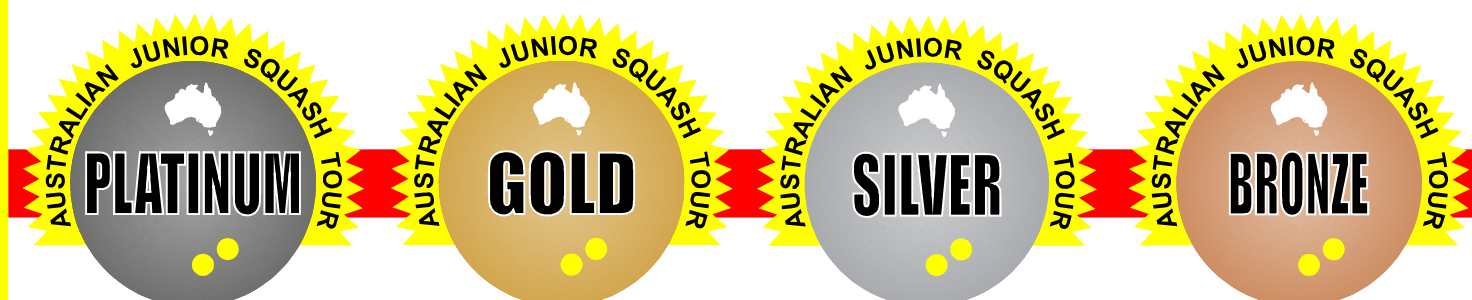

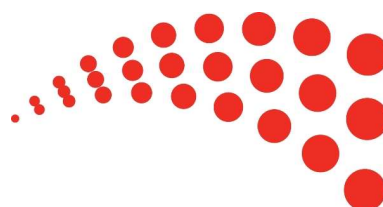

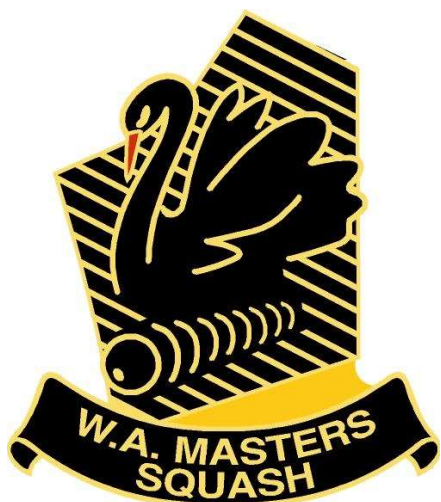
