2019 State Junior Team Selection Criteria

1. Team

- 1.1 The WA Squash 2019 State Junior Team (the Team), comprising up to three boys and three girls in each age group U/13, U/15, U/17 and U/19, will be selected to compete in the 2019 Australian Junior Age Teams Championships (AJC). The age cut-off date will be the last day of the AJC.
- 1.2 The Team will be announced at the conclusion of the WA Squash State Junior Individual and Teams Championships.

2. Eligibility

To be eligible for selection a player must:

- a) satisfy Squash Australia's AJC eligibility criteria
 - b) be a currently-registered financial member of a Club affiliated with WA Squash
- and
- c) not be under suspension.

3. Selectors

A Selection Panel will be appointed by the WA Squash Board on the recommendation of its Coaching Committee.

4. Team Selection

- 4.1 The Selection Panel will select those players who in its opinion will optimise the Team's performance in the AJC.
- 4.2 Players' performances in the period from the 2018 AJC to the selection date will be considered.
- 4.3 A player qualified for a given age group can be selected to compete in a higher age group.

- 4.4 All eligible players may be considered for selection. It is strongly recommended that players seeking selection should compete in at least the WA Squash State Junior Individual and Teams Championships.

5. Appeals

- 5.1 A player not selected in the Team may within seven days of the announcement of the Team lodge with the WA Squash General Manager a written appeal that includes grounds for the appeal.
- 5.2 The WA Squash General Manager shall immediately forward the appeal to the Selection Panel and the Disputes Committee.
- 5.3 The Selection Panel shall within three days provide the General Manager with its reasons for not selecting the appellant and immediately upon their receipt the General Manager shall inform the appellant of those reasons.
- 5.4 Within three further days the appellant must advise the General Manager if the appeal is to be withdrawn or continue.
- 5.5 If the appeal is to continue it will be considered by the WA Squash Disputes Committee in accordance with the WA Squash Grievance/Dispute Resolution Policy. Every endeavour will be made to complete the appeals process within seven days.
- 5.6 If not satisfied with the outcome the appellant may refer the matter to the WA Squash Board for its further consideration.
