Accommodation (Goodstone group)

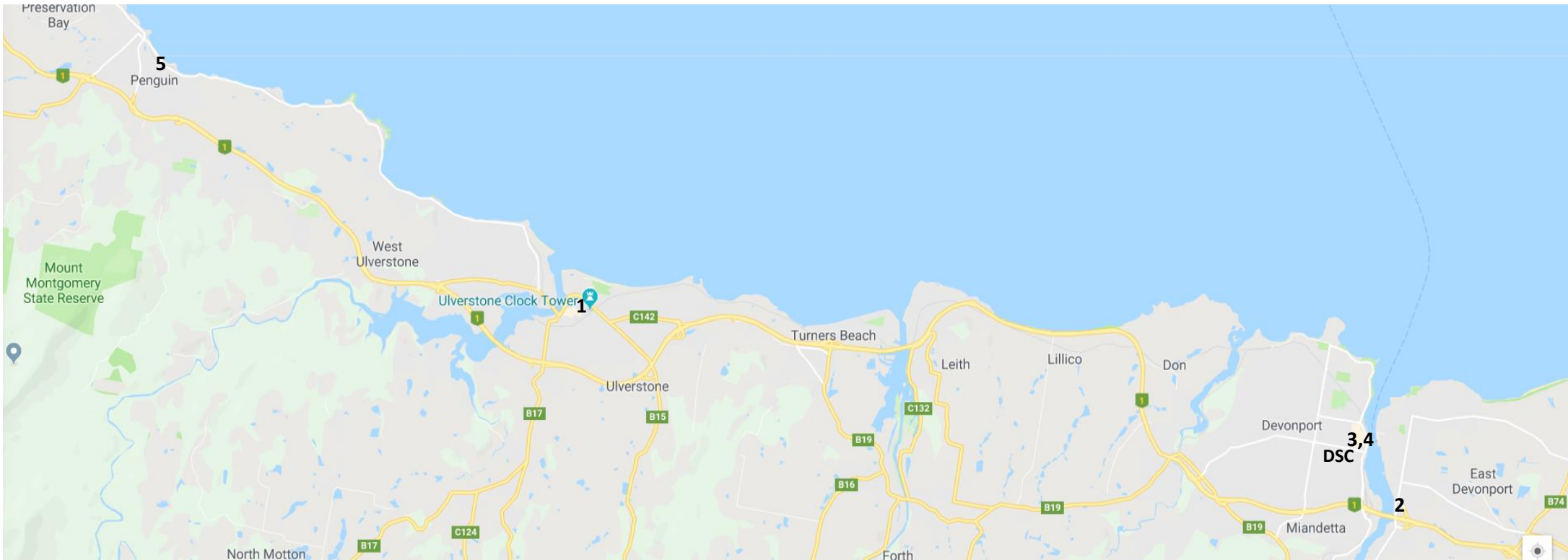

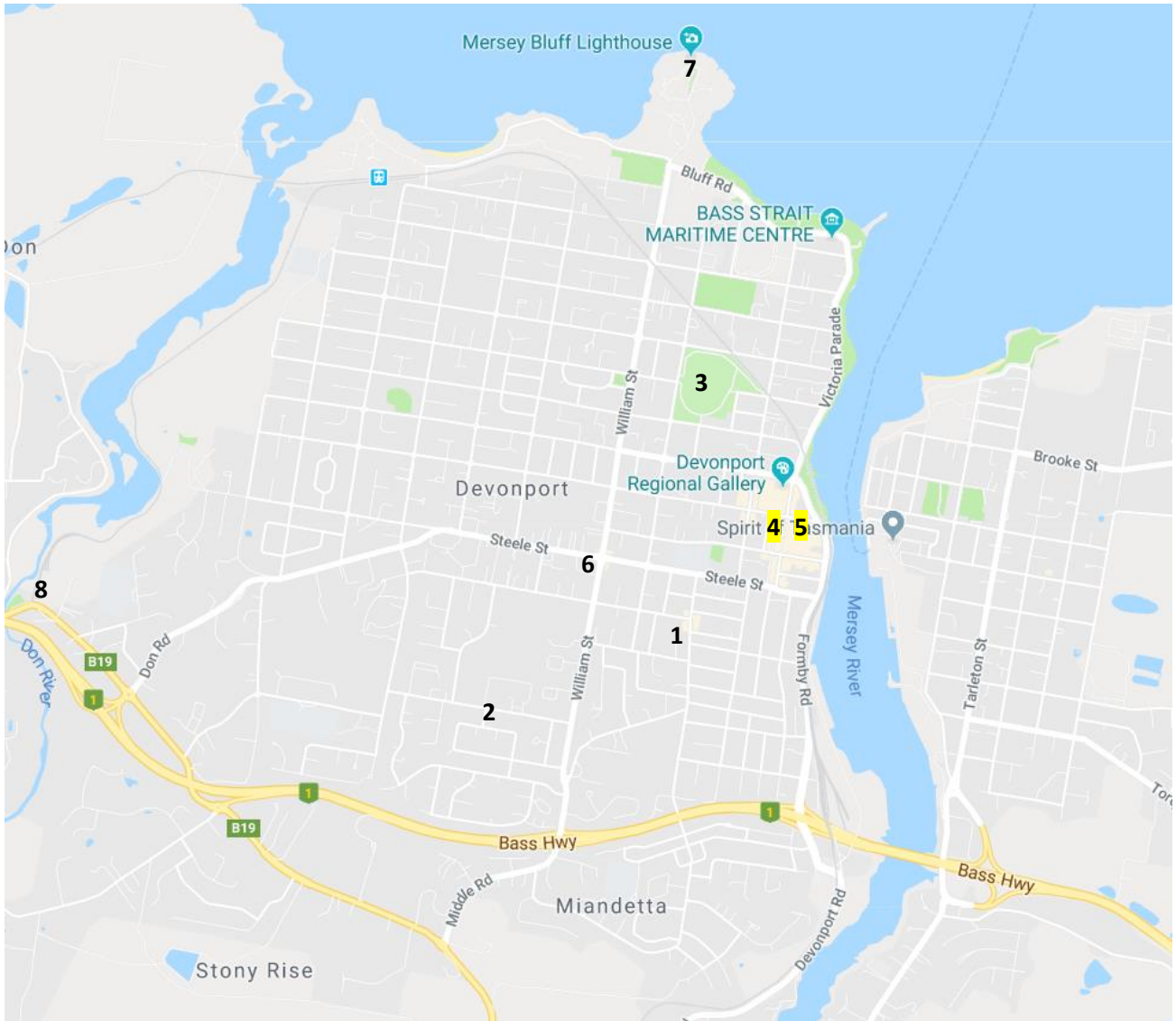

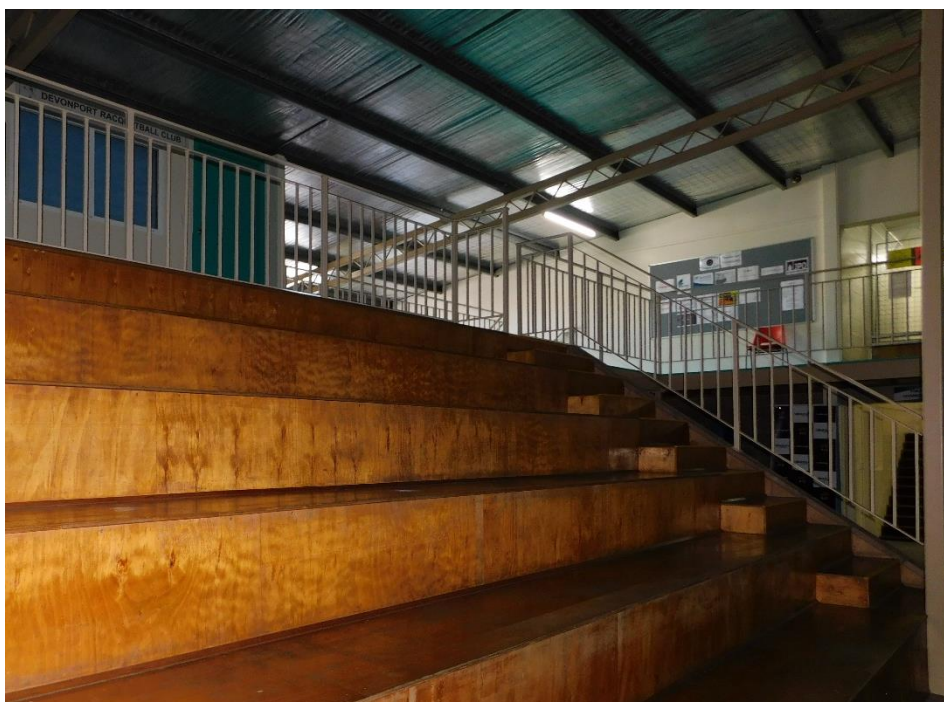

Weather

Being Tasmania, it's generally cold all year round! For late September, early October the average temperature range is from 6°C – 16°C, with rainfall also being fairly common. Good news though, the Devonport Squash Centre has recently installed heating to ensure comfort for both players and spectators alike!

We still do recommend bringing warm clothing though for when you aren't inside the centre.

Food

At the courts

A range of snacks and meals will be available at the Darwin Squash Centre throughout the event. A supermarket is located a few minutes' drive from the Devonport Squash Centre too. (Map ref: 2)

Outside the courts

A highlight of Devonport is the Devonport Farmer's Market (Map reference: 3), held on the 2nd & 4th Saturday of each month (Saturday 28th of September). The markets offer a range of cheap food options and other stalls and entertainment.

Rooke Street Mall (Map reference 4) is about a 3-minute drive from the courts and has a range of shops and variety of dining options.

Getting Around

Everything in Devonport is pretty close, so getting around the city shouldn't be too much of a hassle! If you're hiring a car you will find it very easy to travel to and from the centre as there is plenty of parking on site.

If you're staying close by and travelling on foot remember to drink water along the way and protect yourself from the elements.

The main public transport service are buses through provider Merseylink. The buses travel to most of the destinations on the map provided but you can access more information [here](#).

Devonport also has taxi services as well as the ride share service 'Uber'.

Things to do in Devonport

If you're keen to check out some local sites or have some fun while you're not at the courts here are a few hot spots to head to!

Reading Cinemas Devonport (Map reference: 5) is only a short 5-minute drive from the squash centre if you're looking to catch the latest Hollywood flicks.

Devonport Tenpin Bowl (Map reference: 6) is a 10-minute walk around the corner if you're keen for a Striking day!

Devonport's Farmer's Market (Map reference: 3), otherwise known as 'Australia's market garden', offer some of the most quality fruit and veggie produce money can buy with the farms surrounding Devonport making up 40% of the island's annual crop. Be sure to get down on Saturday the 28th of September to taste it firsthand!

Looking for the best view in town? Then the Mersey Bluff Lighthouse (Map reference: 7) is the place to be! On a clear day you can see for miles, so if you want that million-dollar shot to get bulk likes on Instagram then this is a must visit!

Are you a #CultureVulture? Love a bit of history in your spare time? Ever been on a train? Then it's all aboard to the Don River Railway & Museum (Map reference: 8)! Relax with a train trip on the historic Melrose Line, visit the museum or drop by the workshop.

If you're staying longer there's heaps more to see, with Hobart only a 3 hour drive away (plus the entire island in between) you're spoilt for choice! For more information about the sites and attractions of Tasmania, head to Tasmania.com to get in touch with the people who know it best!
