SUBJECT: 2021 WA SQUASH FEES AND CHARGES

Please be advised that there has been **NO** increase in fees and charges for the forthcoming year 2021.

THE NEW YEAR IS NOW FROM 1ST APRIL 2021 TO 31ST MARCH 2022

Club Affiliation is due In Jan 2021.

All other fees are due from **APRIL 1st 2021**

All fees are **INCLUSIVE** of GST

Club Affiliation Fees to WA Squash.

\$200.00 (2020 - \$200) per year.

Senior Country Player Registration

\$50.00 (2020 - \$50) per player /per year full year (inclusive of insurance)

- Entitles player to enter all WA Squash administered and approved Open and Closed events:

Junior Country Player Registration

\$30.00 (2020- \$30) per player / full year (inclusive of insurance)

- Entitles player to enter all WA Squash administered and approved Open and Closed events as well as all Junior events. This includes Junior Aged Events, Junior Graded Circuit tournaments, WA State Junior Teams Championship, SportyHQ ranking system and Junior Camps.



Why Player Registration is important

Player registration numbers in Squash are vitally important on a number of levels:

1. Player registration revenue is **a vital source of income** for the ongoing administration of our sporting association and in enabling the delivery of the variety of competitions, events and programs we offer. This is particularly so in light of the ever increasing competition for funds from our main funding partners.
2. Player registration paid in WA also assists with the funding of administration at both the National and International levels of the sport. Without registrations paid the World Squash Federation and Squash Australia it would be extremely difficult for those organizations to survive and attend to the administration of squash.
3. **More players insured for injury** through registration is of benefit to all in Squash and will reduce potential liability exposure to the industry
4. The number of registered players is a significant metric by which Squash's main funding partners (DSR and Healthway), and potential commercial sponsors, evaluate WA Squash's funding applications. **The higher the numbers, the greater the chance we have of increasing our funding** to the benefit of all involved with Squash.
5. Player registration provides **valuable information for WA Squash**, allowing the Association to keep players informed on the competitions and programs it runs, and enabling analysis of what is needed to best promote the sport in WA.
